Evan Caplan, a member of Cozen O'Connor's Commercial Litigation Group, and Jim Mulcahy, a paralegal in Cozen O'Connor's Commercial Litigation Group, have been selected as Philadelphia VIP's June Volunteers of the Month. Philadelphia VIP (Volunteers for the Indigent Program) promotes equal justice for the poor by providing civil legal services not otherwise available, collaborating with other legal services organizations and promoting a culture of volunteerism.
