Nevertheless, privacy advocates express concerns that the framework resembles the unsuccessful Privacy Shield and lacks substantial modifications. Businesses managing EU personal data are unlikely to face significant impacts since the DPF process and commitments are similar to the Privacy Shield, although it has additional national security measures to withstand potential EU court challenges.
