Alycen and Elliot will also discuss (1) whether injury caused by the intentional act of a third party qualifies as an "occurrence"; (2) whether faulty workmanship qualifies as an "occurrence."; and (3) the interplay between the definition of "occurrence" and the expected or intended injury exclusion.
